Helen was integral to the support of ECA students and Christian youth. She developed a series of Vacation Bible School programs which still impact hundreds of children each year.

The Leonard ECA Foundation launched in 2004 and was granted 501(c)3 status by the IRS in 2005. The foundation is a public charity with the purpose of coming alongside the supporting churches as well as the ECA school board for the benefit of Evangelical Christian Academy.

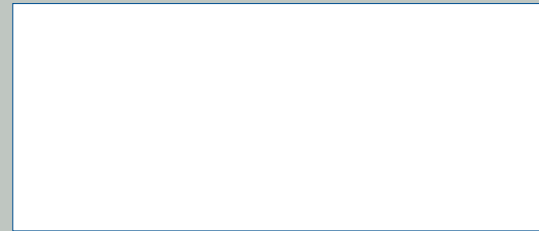
